



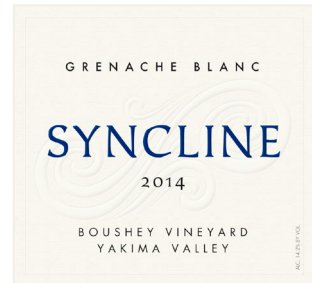
## Wine Tech Notes

### 2014 Grenache Blanc

240 cases produced • 14.2% Alc. By Vol.

#### *Tasting Notes*

This intriguing wine has aromas of asian pear and wet stone, complimented by flavors of star fruit, green apple and hints of anise. The overall acid structure and enticing aromas make this a standout wine.



#### *Harvest Notes*

**Vineyard:** Boushey Vineyard  
**Appellation:** Yakima Valley  
**Varietal:** 100% Grenache Blanc

#### *Vineyards*

Located at high elevation, the celebrated **Boushey Vineyard** produces wines of distinct character with balanced acidity. Layered soils and long, cool, slow ripening time allow for complex flavor development. 2011 was the first harvest using Boushey fruit for Syncline Winery. We are so impressed by the quality, delicious complexity and brilliant acidity, we plan to keep working with this vineyard for the long term.

#### *Vinification*

The fruit was hand harvested and transported to the winery in the early morning. It was then whole cluster pressed and settled overnight. In the morning, it was racked to a concrete egg and a 4 year aged light toast french oak "cigar". Native ferment, blended and bottled in March.
